

## Aylesbury and District Netball League

### Scoring Information

Each team in the Premier Division and Division One must provide 1 umpire and 1 scorer for each match they umpire.

#### Scorers

- All scorers must be affiliated to England Netball.
- Both scorers will be seated together throughout the match.
- They will be positioned behind one of the umpires on the side line away from the Rota table and team benches (preferably alongside the centre third or at a place designated by both umpires).
- Both Scorers will record each goal scored on a normal Score Card. One Scorer will "call" the 'score'. Who this will be, should be agreed prior to the commencement of the game.  
(Umpires may continue to score games and call the 'score' for the first half of the season, unless the Scorers are confident to do so themselves)
- Scorers will also confirm the 'score' at the start and end of each quarter to anyone who requests this information; they will confirm with the umpires the 'centre pass' at the start of each quarter.
- Scorers when "calling" out the 'score' must do so in a loud, clear voice.
- Process for "calling" the 'score' – always call the leading team first.
- Scorers **must not** be involved with their team bench during the game.
- Scorers **must not** participate in the game in any other way i.e. encouraging or coaching teams during the game.
- At the end of the match both Umpires and Scorers should sign any paperwork as required (Umpires, Captains and Scorers will agree that the 'score' is correct).

#### Umpires

- Both umpires must ensure that they indicate the direction of the centre pass after each goal.
- Umpires will "call" the 'score' for the first half of the season, unless the Scorers are confident to do so themselves
- Once Scorers take over "calling" the 'score', Umpires may continue to score the game alongside the Scorers should they wish.

#### Players

- Need to ensure that they look at the umpires after a goal is scored to see the direction of the centre pass.
