

Aylesbury & District Netball League – 2011/12 Season

Umpiring Information

The main points to be aware of for this season are shown below but please take time to read the details within the ADNL League Rules

Provision of Umpires

Each team, when applying to enter the league, must provide the details of at least one umpire who represents their team. Only those named will be allowed to umpire within the league. Additional umpires may be registered during the season, however this must be done prior to them taking control of a match. If your umpire is new to the League we must also see evidence of the AENA 'C' Award or higher. It is mandatory for all umpires to attend the refresher/workshop over a 2 year League period. An umpire under 18 must have a member of the club who is 18 or over with them when they are umpiring. This does not apply to AENA 'C' Award or higher.

Registration

All umpires must be listed on the ADNL Umpire registration form, please use the electronic version wherever possible. A register of umpires will be published at each venue; additionally the League will keep list of umpires willing to umpire for other teams. Please indicate if your umpire is available for other matches on the registration form (Contact Yes/No).

Qualifications

Premier Division & Division 1

Umpires must hold the AENA 'C' award or higher

Divisions (other than Premier & Division 1)

Umpires must hold the ADNL League award or higher.

Should it be necessary, new teams entering the league will have until no later than January of the current playing season to ensure that their umpire meets the standard of, and obtains the ADNL league award.

Match Umpires

The names of match umpires have to be recorded on the sheets at each venue by the Rota Duty Teams. The umpire also has to print & sign the record sheet.
