Supporters

As a Supporter, you are expected to adhere to our Code of Conduct and embrace the spirit of our game.

All Supporters will be deemed to have read and understood this Code and in attending any Aylesbury and District Netball League (ADNL) events or fixtures, agree to behave in a manner which does not contravene any of part of the Code.

As a Supporter I will:

- Comply with ADNL's Constitution, Rules, Equity Policy and all other Procedures / Policies / Regulations.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in netball, regardless of gender, marital status, race, colour, disability, sexuality, age, occupation, religion or political opinion.
- Read the rules of the sport to understand better what I am watching
- Always conduct myself in an appropriate manner.
- Never argue with an official or participant during a game and listen to and cooperate with officials' decisions
- Exercise self-control:
 - I understand that verbal, emotional and physical abuse of Players, Match Officials, Team Officials and Spectators is not acceptable or permitted.
- Treat all Players and Match Officials with respect, never bully or take unfair advantage of anyone.
- Display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
- Abide by any disciplinary sanctions that might be imposed on me or the Team/Club I am supporting.

I will not:

- Arrive at a netball activity under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Consume alcoholic drinks or illegal substances whilst spectating.
- Distract or provoke Players or Match Officials.
- Wager on any match or at any event where I am spectating.
- Offer or attempt to offer, or accept either directly or indirectly, any consideration whatsoever with a view to influencing the result of any match.
- Use Social Media technology to bring the game into disrepute or make an inappropriate comment about a Player, Match Official, Team Official, Connected Participant or Member of the ADNL.
- Take photographs or video images of anyone during match fixtures

I understand that If I fail to follow the code, then ADNL may take action against me under the Disciplinary Regulations, which may result in Sanctions or Suspension.
